SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND UHZ SPORTS MEDICINE INSTITUTE, PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 100-EE10 – SPORTS MEDICINE PROGRAM

The purpose of this Request For Proposals No. 100-EE10 – SPORTS MEDICINE PROGRAM, which opened on April 19, 2005, is to provide a comprehensive sports medicine program of injury prevention, physical screening examinations, evaluation, treatment, and rehabilitation of athletes who participate in the District's interscholastic athletic program in senior high and alternative schools. These services will be provided by the Board at no cost to the student athlete. Additionally, the agency will provide workshops for athletic personnel and area sports medicine clinics for the evaluation, care, and rehabilitation of athletes, as well as consultation services when needed. This is a term proposal. Of 17 proposers sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 3 responded, including 2 no proposals. The Board, at its meeting of February 16, 2005, authorized the issuance of the Request For Proposals and approved the appointment of a Selection Committee.

The Selection Committee met on April 28, 2005 to evaluate the only proposal received in response to the Request For Proposals. The proposal received from UHZ Sports Medicine Institute, of Coral Gables, Florida, was considered by the committee. Based on the discussion, the Committee recommended UHZ Sports Medicine Institute for award.
