The purpose of this bid, opened on August 10, 2004, is to establish a contract, to administer, at a firm unit price, physical examinations of bus drivers, south of Flagler Street, for the Department of Transportation. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 17 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 3 responded, with 2 bids meeting specifications and 1 no bid.

Identical bids were received from Legion Park Medical Center, of Miami, Florida, and Preventive Medicine Testing Centers, Inc., d.b.a., Global MRO, of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The recommendation reflects an award to Legion Park Medical Center, the Miami-Dade County vendor, other than the Minority/Women Business Enterprise vendor, pursuant to Board Rule 6Gx13- 3C-1.061 -- Identical Prices -- Priorities for Award.
