Procurement Management Services, at the request of the Office of Adult Vocational and Community Education, released the above-referenced solicitation. The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to determine qualified and experienced Community and Faith-Based Organizations capable of providing adult educational programs in conjunction with grant requirements. This RFP was advertised on the Procurement Management Services website, the Demandstar website, BidNet and Florida Bid, as well as e-mailed to 296 potential bidders, which included seventeen (17) Micro Business Enterprise (MBE) vendors registered to these commodity codes, none of which were non-profit organizations.

The initial term of the bid shall be for one (1) year, commencing July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, and may, by mutual agreement between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the successful bidders, be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. } **REVISED**

Strategies were employed to increase Small Business Enterprise/Micro Business Enterprise (SBE/MBE) participation. The Goal Setting Committee recommended that this solicitation be open with a 5% SBE/MBE preference.

Ten (10) vendors responded to this advertised bid, all of which were non-profit organizations. Based on the criteria listed in the solicitation and the recommendations from the Selection Committee members, the contract shall be awarded to ten (10) vendors.
