SUBJECT: AWARD INVITATION TO BID NO. ITB-21-014-TA - FENCE AND GATES, FURNISH AND INSTALL

Procurement Management Services, at the request of Facilities Operations Maintenance, released the above-referenced solicitation. The purpose of this Invitation to Bid (ITB) is to establish a contract with pre-approved vendors to furnish and install chain link fences, gates, accessories, and related services at Miami-Dade County Public Schools' facilities. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase services as needed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Awarded vendors will be invited to participate in site scope meetings and the Request for Quotations (RFQ) process. Per this ITB, projects under \$1,000 will be awarded on a rotating basis. This ITB was advertised on the Procurement Management Services website, as well as DemandStar. The solicitation was shared with the District's Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO) for additional community outreach.

The initial term of the bid shall be for a period of three (3) years, commencing August 15, 2022 through August 14, 2025, and may, by mutual agreement between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the successful bidders, be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods.

The Goal Setting Committee recommended that this solicitation be open with a 2% price preference for SBE/MBE certified firms to be applied during the RFQ process.

Eleven (11) vendors responded to this advertised bid, of which one (1) was non-responsive. Based on the criteria listed in the solicitation, the contract shall be awarded to ten (10) vendors meeting the minimum requirements, of which seven (7) are certified.

M-DCPS OEO staff verified the Small, Micro, Veteran and/or M/WBE certification status of the firm(s).

In Fiscal Year 2021-2022, the District spent \$485,500 on fence and gates services.
