Procurement Management Services, at the request of the Department of Food and Nutrition, released the above-referenced solicitation. The purpose of this Invitation to Bid (ITB) is to establish a contract, at firm unit prices, to provide exhaust hood and duct cleaning services for specified school food-service locations, for the Department of Food and Nutrition and Hospitality Services. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase services, as may be needed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. This ITB was advertised on the Procurement Management Services website and DemandStar. This contract impacts 414 schools across the District, which breaks down to an annual amount of \$604 per location, based on the annual contract amount of \$250,000. The solicitation was shared with the District's Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO) for additional community outreach.

The initial term of the bid shall be for a period of two (2) years, commencing January 17, 2024 through January 16, 2026, and may, by mutual agreement between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the successful bidders, be extended for three (3) additional one (1) year periods.

Pursuant to School Board Policy 6320.02, the Goal Setting Committee recommended that this solicitation be open with a 5% price preference for any SBE and MBE certified firms.

Four (4) vendors responded to this advertised bid. M-DCPS OEO staff verified the Small, Micro, Veteran and/or M/WBE certification status of the firm(s). Based on the criteria listed in the solicitation, the contract will be awarded to two (2) vendors, of which none are certified.

In Fiscal Year 2022-2023, the District spent \$135,190 on exhaust hood and duct cleaning services.
