L PREPARING OF BIDS

- A. BIDDER QUALIFICATION FORM qualifies the bidder and the bid and must be completed and submitted as page 1 of the bid.
- PERFORMANCE SECURITY. The form of performance security the bidder will submit, when required to do so, must be furnished. Performance security shall not be submitted with the bid.
- BEDDER CERTIFICATION AND DENTIFICATION. Bid must contain an original manual signature from an authorized representative. An unsigned bid will be considered non responsive.
- B. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS define conditions of the bid.
- ORDER OF PRECEDENCE. Any inconsistency in this bid shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:

- 2. FOR MAUBE designated bids. - A Prior to opening, a solicitation may be canceled in whole or in part, prior to the date and hour specified in the Bidder Qualification Form for receipt of bids, when the Associate Superintendent, Bureau of Procurement and Materials Management, determines in writing that such action is in the best interest of the Board for reasons including, but not limited to:
- 1. The Board no longer requires the supplies, services, or construction;

- C. OFFICIAL AWARD DATE. Awards become official when made unless otherwise specified in the award recommendation.
- D. PURCHASE ORDERS. Purchase orders maled to successful bidders are the official notification to deliver materials described therein; and the time allowed for delivery begins with the date of the purchase order. I PREPARAG DE RIOS

A BIDDERS RESPONSIBILITY. Each tidder shall carefully examine the Instructions to Bidders, specifications, Special Conditions listed and the number of schools to be served. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to be fully informed as to the number and widespread locations of school. This will be of vital importance to assure the required schedule deliveries arrive on time.

IL AWARDS

A. BASIS FOR AWARDS. The awards of all items on this kid will made on the basis of low bid meeting specifications, when the portion cost is within the acceptable cost range as determined by the Department of Food and Nutrition.

Award of Items using USDA D.f.
