L PREPARING OF BIDS

- A BIDDER QUALIFICATION FORM qualifies the bidder and the bid and must be completed and submitted as page 1 of the bid.
- PERFORMANCE SECURITY. The form of performance security the kidder will submit, when required to do so, must be furnished. Performance security shall not be submitted with the kid.
- 2. BEDDER CERTIFICATION AND DENTIFICATION. Bid must contain an original manual signature from an authorized representative. An unsigned bid will be considered non responsive.
- 8. INSTRUCTIONS TO BODDERS define conditions of the bit
- 1. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE. Any inconsistency in this bid shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:
 - A. Specifications
 - B. Special Conditions
 - C. Instructions To Bidders
- 2. FOR MAYBE designated bids. - A Prior to opening, a solicitation may be canceled in whole or in part, prior to the date and hour specified in the Eldder Qualification Form for receipt of bids, when the Associate Superintendent, Bureau of Procurement and Materials Management, determines in writing that such action is in the best interest of the Board for reasons including, but not limited to:
