Questions for ITB-17-016-CV, Disaster Debris Removal Monitoring and Recovery Services

The following list addresses the questions received regarding the above-mentioned solicitation:

1. 2.2.10 Performance security bond: Will this actually be a requirement under the scope of services?

**Yes, it is a requirement for this ITB**

2. Pricing - Can you provide the pricing from the prior successful awarded bidder?

**Please visit the Procurement website – Bid # 006-LL10.**

3. Would The School Board consider either removing the Performance or Payment Bond requirement, or considering adding “professional liability” insurance as an alternate for the following reasons:

- Bonding requirement could be considered as limiting competition and in violation of Title 2, Part 200 CFR
- As a “monitoring” contract, The School Board is engaging the selected firm for “professional services” not “contracting” work (i.e. debris hauling). The monitoring contract requires personnel, the hauling contract requires equipment (i.e. trucks, loaders, etc.).
- Most professional engineering firms only carry professional liability insurance since they are in the field of providing professional services.
- Contractors, on the other hand, typically only carry performance bonds because they are in the field of construction.
- By imposing this requirement, you would be eliminating what otherwise would be qualified firms from competing, let alone small and/or minority owned businesses.

**No, MDCPS will not consider any changes to the current requirement.**

4. The School Board may want to consider taking out “Local Preference” out of this procurement as it is discouraged under 200.319 Competition (see below) and therefore be deemed not “eligible” for FEMA Reimbursement.

The "§200.319 Competition. Section 7.b " states " The Non-Federal entity must conduct procurements in a manner that prohibits the use of statutorily or administratively

imposed state, local, or tribal geographical preferences in the evaluation of bids or proposals, ... "

**As stipulated in section 1.15, Local Preference, ... "The preference does not apply to goods or services exempted by Statute as reflected in School Board Policy 6320, or prohibited by Federal or State law, or other funding source restrictions".**

5. Section 1.39 Duty to Defend

Will The School Board consider either taking this requirement out of the contract, or accepting modification to this language to limit the exposure to the awarded bidder's actual performance and not work "incidental"? Otherwise, the awarded bidder could be required to defend actions of other parties' negligence and not their own (i.e. Hauler).

**No, MDCPS will not modify this requirement.**

6. Will the School accept an Automated Debris Management System in lieu of a paper ticketing system? Many other hiring entities are going to this system as it prevents tickets from being lost, allows for real-time data reports, and a host of other advantages.

**Yes. MDCPS will accept an Automated Debris Management System.**

7. Would the School please clarify those "deliverables"? The concern is that there is a requirement that the "Bidder shall be responsible for reviewing the debris hauler's deliverables and invoices and certifying their consistency with the Bidder's deliverables and invoices and for resolving any discrepancies that may exist." This can be misinterpreted to read that the "Monitoring Company" for not fault of his own, can be potentially penalized for the "Hauler's" inability to generate and correct invoices in a timely manner.

**The monitoring company will not be responsible for any inconsistencies due to a Hauler's invoicing.**

8. In no more than eight (8) pages, the Bidder must include the following information within the submitted proposal"  
Does the 8-page limitation only apply to items a-h listed as requirements, or is this the total proposal page count?

**The 8 page limitation only applies to items a-h.**

9. Is this the total amount of the Surety that will be needed for contract award? Conflicts with Section 2.2.10

**No. The Surety letter is not the same as bonding requirement. Please see section 2.2.10, #2 (Awards of \$500,000 or less), C: 1 and 2.**

10. Is there a weighted scale for specific sections of the proposal (i.e. qualifications, references, etc.) that will be utilized that is public, as there is no scoring matrix listed in the proposal?

**No, there is no weighted scale.**

11. Does The School Board intent to have multiple awards or a single award?

**MDCPS will decide what is in the best interest of the District.**

12. Is there a limit on the number of pages for this proposal?

**No, there is not.**

13. Is there an incumbent for this RFP or with similar scope of work? If, yes, please list the current contractor and describe the task current contractor is assigned.
