Pursuant to Request For Proposals No. 040-FF10 - PROGRAM EVALUATION CONSULTANT SERVICES, which was awarded on April 18, 2006, proposals would be solicited on the anniversary of each yearly extension period, in order to expand the pool of eligible providers for consulting services.
