Special Conditions

01-PURPOSE

The purpose of this bid is to establish a contract, at firm unit prices, for the purchase of estimated requirements, for the items listed, from date of award through July 31, 2006 and may, by mutual agreement between Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the successful bidder(s), be extended for three (3) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, 90 days beyond the expiration date of the current contract period. Procurement Management Services, may, if considering to extend, request a letter of intent to extend from the successful bidder, prior to the end of the current contract period. All prices shall be firm for the term of the contract. The successful bidder(s) agrees to this condition by signing its bid.

02-INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Successful vendor(s) are required to have insurance coverage as specified in the indemnity and insurance form(s), attached hereto and made part of this bid. The successful vendor(s) must submit completed certificate of insurance form(s), prior to being recommended for award. Failure to submit this form(s), as noted, will result in the vendor(s) not being recommended for the bid award.

03-QUALIFICATIONS OF VENDORS

Award of this contact will be made to all qualified vendors who meet the applicable criteria, as follows:

- A. Have a fully equipped collision repair shop, as required in this solicitation, and may be verified by an on-site inspection by M-DCPS personnel.
- B. The company must have a minimum of four (4) full time employees.
- C. The company must be able to show a minimum of at least one (1) year of experience in bodywork repair, refurbishment and painting.
- D. Have a facility size of at least 2,500 square feet which will allow for two standard size cars to be worked on completely inside.
- E. The facility must have a spray booth large enough to accommodate cars, light and medium trucks, as applicable.
- F. The facility must provide security in the form of a fenced locked lot, or the inside of a secure building, for no less than two (2) standard sized vehicles will be defined as a 2003 Ford Crown Victoria Police Car.
- G. Facility must be located within the boundaries of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

04-QUALIFYING OF BIDDERS AND ASSIGNMENT OF WORK

These bidders shall be qualified during the bid evaluation process to participate in periodic work assignments that are identified by M-DCPS, on an as needed basis.
