CONTRACT EXTENSION SUMMARY

Contract No.: 109-FF09

Contract Title: INDUSTRIAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES DISCOUNT BID

Extension Award Amount: \$4,724,935.24

Extension Period: September 1, 2008 – August 31, 2009

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to establish a pool of pre-qualified distributors and manufacturers, to purchase Maintenance Repair and Operating (MRO) industrial equipment and supplies, for Maintenance Operations.

Original Award Period: September 13, 2006 – August 31, 2008

Terms of Contract Award and Extension: Approximately two (2) years, with an option to extend for three (3) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date.

Previous Extension Period: N/A

Previous Extension Amount: \$7,000,000

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period, to benefit from firm percentage discounts. This contract generates significant vendor participation in the competitive solicitation process. Awarded vendors will be invited to submit quotations for various groups of MRO items for Maintenance Operations and Maintenance Materials Management (MMM), for any single requisition exceeding the threshold for quotations or a group of commodities, to establish a firm-fixed price agreement. Maintenance Materials Management items covered by a term price agreement will be purchased, utilizing a Procurement credit card. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendors and recommends extension. This is the first extension of the contract. The awardees have agreed to extend for an additional one (1) year period, by letter, on file.
