



CONTRACT EXTENSION SUMMARY

Contract No.: 127-EE10

Contract Title: FURNISH AND INSTALL FENCE AND GATES

Extension Award Amount: \$203,511.99

Extension Period: December 11, 2008 – March 10, 2009

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to purchase and install fences and gates, for schools and facilities, for Maintenance Operations.

Original Award Period: December 11, 2005 – December 10, 2006

Terms of Contract Award and Extension: One (1) year, with an option to extend for two (2) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date.

Previous Extension Period: December 11, 2007 – December 10, 2008

Previous Extension Amount: \$1,202,185.10

Vendors Recommended for Contract Extension: One (1)

Gomez & Son Fence

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional ninety (90) day period, to benefit from fixed prices and continuity of service. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendor and recommends extension. This is the final extension of the contract.
