

CONTRACT EXTENSION SUMMARY

Contract Title: INTERCOM, MASTER CLOCK AND PA SOUND-SYSTEM
TURNKEY INSTALLATION AND REPAIR (REBID)

Extension Award Amount: \$150,716.13

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to establish pre-approved vendors, to purchase complete turnkey installation, upgrade and repair, including labor, design, engineering, supervision, equipment and materials necessary, and to provide a complete intercom, master clock and PA sound systems, for Maintenance Materials Management.

Original Award Period: January 16, 2008 – January 15, 2009

Terms of Contract Award and Extension: One (1) year, with an option to extend for four (4) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date.

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period, to benefit from firm fixed prices. Benchmarking for this bid cannot be completed due to the fact that it is structured differently than all other counties and pre-approves vendors. This is the first extension of the contract. The awardees have agreed to extend for an additional one (1) year period, by letter, on file.

One additional vendor will be added to the list of pre-approved vendors on bid, as per Special Condition #2, whereas “proposals will be solicited on the anniversary of each extension period, in order to expand the pool of eligible providers for complete turnkey installation, including all labor, supervision, equipment, materials, testing and training of a complete surveillance camera systems, closed circuit television systems.” The vendor recommended for addition to the contract, for the period January 16, 2009, to January 15, 2010, is Rauland-Borg Corporation of Florida.
