Contract Title: SPEECH AND HEARING EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES,
CATALOG DISCOUNT

Extension Award Amount: \$80,028

Extension Period: February 16, 2009 – February 15, 2010

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to establish pre-qualified vendors, at the highest, firm percentage discounts, as may be required, of speech and hearing equipment and accessories, for various locations. Equipment purchased through this contract will be used to support students with speech and hearing impairments.

Original Award Period: February 16, 2005 – February 15, 2007

Terms of Contract Award and Extension: Two (2) years, with an option to extend for three (3) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date.

Previous Extension Period: February 16, 2008 – February 15, 2009

Previous Extension Amount: \$80,028

Comments: This contract extension to provide office supplies to the District was approved as a Superintendent's Extension of Contracts on February 3, 2009. However, Prentke Romich Co. was inadvertently omitted from the list of vendors recommended for contract extension. This contract extension summary reflects an increase of vendors recommended for contract extension, for Speech and Hearing Equipment and Accessories Catalog Discount, from fourteen (14) to fifteen (15) vendors and includes Prentke Romich Co., as a recommended vendor.

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period, to benefit from continuity of service. Competitive quotes are solicited from the awarded vendors to ensure the District is achieving the best pricing available based on current market conditions. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendors and recommends extension. This is the third extension and fifth year of the contract. The awardees have agreed to extend for an additional one (1) year period, by letter, on file.
