

CONTRACT EXTENSION SUMMARY

Contract No.: 109-JJ06

Contract Title: AIR CONDITIONERS, BARD

Recommended Extension Award Amount: \$200,000

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to purchase Bard air conditioners, at firm unit prices, for Maintenance Materials Management stock.

Terms of Contract Award and Extension: One (1) year, with an option to extend for two (2) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date.

Vendors Recommended for Contract Extension: One (1)
Tropic Supply, Inc.

Cost Savings: No

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period, to benefit from fixed prices and continuity of service. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendor and recommends extension. This is the first extension of the contract.
