



## CONTRACT EXTENSION SUMMARY

Contract Title: BRAKE DRUMS AND BRAKE-LINING KITS

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to purchase at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of brake drum and brake-lining kits, for the Department of Transportation, Vehicle Maintenance.

Terms of Contract Award and Extension: One (1) year, with an option to extend for three (3) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date.

Vendors Recommended for Contract Extension: Two (2)

Cost Savings: No

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period, to benefit from fixed prices and continuity of service. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendors and recommends extension. This is the final extension of the contract. The awardees have agreed to extend for an additional one (1) year period, by letter, on file.
