



Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to provide, at a firm buyer's premium, all necessary labor, materials and equipment, to conduct auctions for the sale of all supplies and/or equipment determined to be surplus or obsolete, for The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Terms of Contract Award and Extension: Eighteen (18) months, with an option to extend for two (2) additional eighteen (18) month periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date.

Vendors Recommended for Contract Extension: One (1)

National Auction Company, Inc.

Cost Savings: No

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional eighteen (18) month period, to benefit from fixed prices and continuity of service. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendor and recommends extension. This is the second extension of the contract. The awardee has agreed to extend for an additional eighteen (18) month period, by letter, on file.
