Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an

additional one (1) year period, to benefit from fixed prices and continuity of service, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI), as of January 2013, indicated an increase of 0.3% with an annual index of 1.6%. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendors and recommends extension. This extension is based on the terms, conditions and pricing contained in the original contract approved by the School Board.

Benchmark:

Benchmarking was conducted against The School Board of Palm Beach County,

Florida, and the District's prices were found to be approximately 13% lower.
