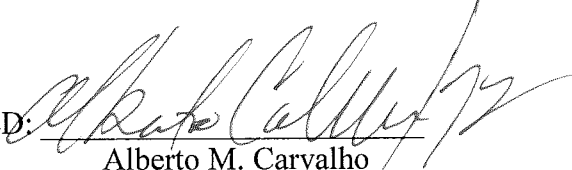

CONTRACT EXTENSION SUMMARY

Contract No.: 001-MM04

Contract Title: AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR SERVICE AND SPECIALIZED REPAIRS FOR SCHOOL BOARD VEHICLES

Board Meeting Date: December 14, 2011 – Agenda Item E-146

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to purchase, at firm labor rates, parts, discounts, and/or markups, quantities, as may be required, of automotive repair services and specialized repairs, for School Board vehicles, for the Department of Transportation, Vehicle Maintenance.

Initial Award Amount: \$1,600,000

Initial Contract Award Period and Extension: December 14, 2011 – December 5, 2013
One (1) year, with an option to extend for four (4) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date of the current contract period.

Current Extension Amount: \$626,020

Current Extension Period: December 6, 2013 – December 5, 2014

Recommended Extension Award Amount: \$219,575

Recommended Extension Period: December 6, 2014 – March 5, 2015
This is the second extension of the contract. The awardees have agreed to extend for an additional ninety (90) day period, by letter, on file.

Cost Savings: Yes The reduction in the recommended extension award, in the amount of \$219,575 compared to the original award, reflects actual expenditures. Additionally, two vendors offered discounts: ABC Radiator & Air, Inc. offered a 15% discount and Arrow Muffler offered a 20% discount.

Justification: It is considered to be in the best interest of the District to extend this contract for an additional ninety (90) day period, to benefit from fixed prices and continuity of service. Staff has indicated satisfactory performance from the vendors and recommends extension. This extension is based on the terms, conditions and pricing contained in the original contract approved by the School Board.
