

Purpose of Contract: The purpose of this contract is to establish a list of preapproved vendors, to purchase, at firm unit prices, and discounts, quantities, as may be required, of Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEM) parts and service, for the Department of Transportation, Vehicle Maintenance.

Initial Award Amount: \$500,000

Initial Contract Award Period and Extension: December 5, 2012 – December 4, 2014
Two (2) years, with an option to extend for three (3) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date of the current contract period.

Current Extension Amount: N/A

Current Extension Period: N/A

Recommended Extension Award Amount: \$126,941

Recommended Extension Period: December 5, 2014 – March 4, 2015
