As detailed in the bid documents in Special Conditions #5, quantities listed are estimated quantities and while delivery could be more than 150 cases at a time to the M-DCPS Warehouse (W/H), it can not be guaranteed that more could be sent at one time.

Bids can be viewed at the M-DCPS Procurement website 24/7/366. Bid titles vary, depending on the type of items that are grouped together for each bid solicitation. On the M-DCPS Procurement Website, one can view bids that were issued, awarded, and extended as far back as 2003. The most recent cafeteria bids that have paper products are 058-FF03, 007-GG03, 039-HH03 (partial award) and 065-HH03 (partial award). On the two bids that are partially awarded, the remaining items are under evaluation and will be awarded at a future board meeting.
