Q & A:

Below, are questions requesting clarification of information relating to bid solicitation 096-GG09, and M-DCPS response:

(1)

Q. 1. Who determines the estimated number of hours projected to complete each project assigned, and how many of the contractor's personnel will be allowed to work on an individual project?

A. 1. The assigned contractor on a project will provide the project manager or Special Project Consultant (SPC) of the estimated Time & Material for the project, prior to the commencement of work. This estimate will be reviewed by the project manager or SPC for reasonableness prior to issuing a Notice-To-Commence (NTC).

Q. 2. Will the hourly labor rate apply to each person working on the project at the job site?

A. 2. Yes, the hourly labor rate will apply to each of the contractor's personnel working on the project at the job site. In addition, the hourly labor rate applies to all levels of personnel, including Supervisors and Foremen.
