The 354 DOT alcohol tests were reflective as the 10% randoms and follow-ups. There were only 10 tests conducted last year. Should we give a price for both on-site drug and alcohol? **ALCOHOL TESTING ONLY PLEASE.**

SINCE ITEMS 6 IS A NEW ITEM FOR US TO REQUEST, WE USED THE SAME NUMBER AS ITEM 4 SO THAT IN THE EVENT THAT ALL ALCOHOL TESTING IS DONE ON SITE THIS WOULD BE AN APPROXIMATE NUMBER.**

Can Dade County Schools disclose if breath alcohol randoms are done at collection facilities or by mobile on-site testing? **BREATH ALCOHOL TESTS ARE CURRENTLY PERFORMED AT COLLECTION SITES. ON SITE TESTING IS A NEW ITEM THAT IS BEING REQUESTED.**
