

QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 081-NN10 – SPORTS MEDICINE
PROGRAM

1. With regards to the implementation timeline, I understand September 3 would be the date the award would be released. Our question is what is the date the services would be expected to begin?

RESPONSE: October 31, 2013. The current contract extension expires on October 30, 2013.

2. Please clarify, with regards to the physician examinations, are two orthopedic surgeons/1 general practitioners required at each site, or can P.A.s provide the physical examinations?

RESPONSE: Current past practice has allowed a minimum of one orthopedic surgeon at each physical examination site and P.A.s to fill in the other physician requirements.

3. Please explain in detail, Section VI, Paragraph 2, what will be quarterly payment for services include? What specific itemized expenses are required?

RESPONSE: Quarterly payment would include cost for services in Section VII of RFP. Section VII, F. Costs. The proposer must provide a cost factor for approximately 10,000 physical examinations. There are approximately 37 sites for each physical screening examination. Additionally, proposer must provide a cost factor per year per sports medicine clinic site; a cost factor per physician per game; a cost factor per year for Chief of Sports Medicine; and a cost factor for in-service seminars.
